From the South Bay (e.g. Fremont)

Take 880 North into Oakland

Exit at the Broadway exit

Turn right at the bottom of the ramp on to Broadway

Go five blocks, turn right onto 11th street.

From points East

Take 580 West to Oakland

Use 980 to Downtown Oakland

Take the 12th street exit

Turn left on 11th Street.

Follow 11th street for 10-12 blocks until it crosses Broadway.

Turn right for paid parking under the building.

From points North

Take 80 West to the Junction with 580

Stay in the left lane and take 580 East

Take 980 to downtown Oakland.

Take the 12th street exit

Turn left on 11th Street.

Follow 11th street for 10-12 blocks until it crosses Broadway.

Turn right for paid parking under the building.

BART- 12th Street BART station is one block away.

FROM 580W – Take the Estudillo Avenue exit towards downtown * Turn right on Macarthur Blvd* Turn left on Estudillo Avenue* Turn right on E 14TH * Turn left on Davis Street* Turn right on San Leandro Blvd * Turn right into the first driveway.

FROM 880S – Take the Davis Street. Exit * Turn left on Davis Street, * Turn left on San Leandro Blvd. * Turn right into the first driveway.

FROM 880N – Take the Davis Street Exit * Turn right on Davis Street. * Turn left on San Leandro Blvd. * Turn right into the first driveway.
