	(2) Smoking prohibited except in truck cabs when no non-smoking employees are present.							
	(3) Up to 25 percent or 50 percent (depending on sq. footage) may be designated smoking by management.							
	(4) Smoking not allowed during food/beverage service, set-up and clean-up.
